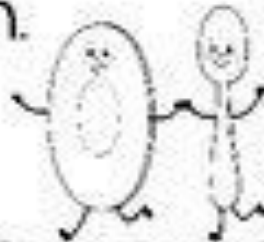


Hey Diddle Diddle

Instructions for Hey Diddle Diddle Sequencing:

Development Area: math ordering and patterning, fine motor.

Have your child cut the numbers one, two, three and four on the line. Place the numbers on top of, under, or over the images of the animals, dish and spoon. Or, your child can cut the images on the line and match them to the numbers.

To extend the activity, use spatial words: over, under, on top, as well as ordinal language: first, second, third and fourth. Also, the images and numbers can be played as a memory game. Additionally, you can cut the images and glue on craft sticks. Use them as props to tell the rhyme.
