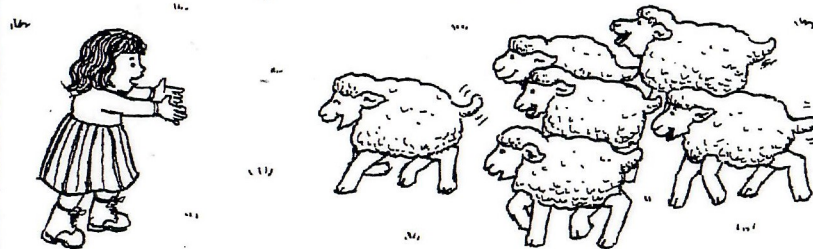
LITTLE BO PEEP

Help Little Bo Peep Find Her Sheep

Please help your child learn and remember the Little Bo Peep rhyme. To extend your child's learning, you may choose to do the following activity.

Developmental Area: literacy, fine motor and creative arts.

Instructions

This activity uses rhyme for developmental reading. Also, it uses fine motor skills and creative arts to strengthen children's finger muscles and spark their imagination and problem-solving skills.

Items needed:

- Child friendly scissors (each child received a pair with the home visit back pack).
- White copy paper
- Curly white gift ribbon or white paper cut into strips
- Black Crayon or marker
- Paint (optional)
- Glue stick

To make the sheep body, use your child's handprint, traced on white paper. You may also use white paint for the handprint, that has dried. Most children love to paint their hand and make a print.

Next, your child can draw "feet" using a black marker or crayon.

Then, your child can cut strips of white paper or cut strips from the white ribbon (moms may need to help curl the ribbon or paper), and glue onto their hand print with a glue stick.

Finally, Little Bo Peep can find her sheep! Have fun!!
